Biography

Dr. Fei-Peng Lee is the President of the Taiwan Hospital Association (since 2023) and an Emeritus Professor and Trustee of Taipei Medical University (TMU). A distinguished otolaryngologist, he earned his MD from TMU and completed his residency at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital before serving as President of the Taiwan Society of Otorhinolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery.

Dr. Lee is a titan of hospital administration, having served as Superintendent of all three TMU-affiliated hospitals: Taipei Medical University Hospital, Wan-Fang Hospital, and Shuang-Ho Hospital. Notably, he led each institution to achieve Joint Commission International (JCI) accreditation, cementing his reputation for excellence in governance and patient safety.

His leadership extends to the Taiwan Nongovernmental Hospitals and Clinics Association and the Taipei Institute of Pathology. Dr. Lee remains a pivotal figure in advancing Taiwan's healthcare quality, academic innovation, and international medical cooperation.
